Dear Anthony:

At its November 20-21, 2017 meeting, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) Committee on Recognition reviewed the Interim Report submitted by the Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Management Education (CAHME). This is to inform you that the committee accepted the report.

With regard to CHEA Standard 12B5 of the *2010 CHEA Recognition of Accrediting Organizations Policy and Procedures*, the committee noted that the description of the CAHME accreditation actions posted on its Website identifies the CAHME accreditation criteria for progress reports and adverse accreditation actions, while those programs that have completed all requirements are noted to be in full compliance with all CAHME criteria. Moving forward, and as part of enhancing the information to the public, CAHME is encouraged to (1) provide information regarding the accredited status of each accredited program, not only those reviewed recently; (2) include a brief description of the issues when a standard is cited as not fully met; and (3) include information for each program, rather than using a single description of the bases or reasons for groups of programs.

CAHME was last recognized by CHEA in September 2014. The second interim report, as called for in the *2010 CHEA Recognition of Accrediting Organizations Policy and Procedures*, will be due July 1, 2020 for consideration at the November 2020 committee meeting.
