

The CAHME - Tim Campbell Scholarship



Tim Campbell believed in hard work and selfless service in his professional and personal life, and reminded his friends, family, and colleagues that true success is measured through relationships that help others reach their full potential. The CAHME - Tim Campbell Scholarship recognizes a student from a CAHME-accredited program who embodies Tim's spirit of service and volunteerism. The Scholarship will provide \$2,000 to the named candidate. The Scholarship is funded by friends and colleagues of Tim Campbell, including Tim's fellow members of the CAHME Board of Directors.

ELIGIBILITY

Full or part-time students in good standing in CAHME-accredited programs in the United States or Canada are eligible to receive the scholarship.

NOMINATION

The nomination will be made by a faculty member of a CAHME-accredited program. Each program can nominate no more than one student. We will not accept direct applications from students. The nomination should consist of an essay of no more than 500 words describing how the nominee embodies a spirit of volunteerism and service that helps others.

SELECTION PROCESS

Nominations will be reviewed by a committee of the CAHME Board of Directors and friends/colleagues of Tim Campbell.

REQUIREMENTS

Applications must include:

- 1) Student name and contact information
- 2) Name of CAHME-accredited program attending
- 3) Nomination Essay (no more than 500 words)
- 4) Nominator information

DEADLINES and SCHEDULE

Applications must be submitted via email to Eric Hamscher at ehamscher@cahme.org by **5:00 pm on November 21, 2018**. Nominations will be reviewed by the Selection Committee and a winner announced in January 2019.
