




History of Rankings of U.S. News & World Report

- 1983: US News & World Report ranked the "top 50" undergraduate colleges.
- 1985: repeated due to popular demand
- 1987: published annually in magazine. "America's Best Colleges" issued as a separate publication.
 - Expanded to include:
 - research universities
 - liberal arts colleges
 - graduate schools of law, business, medicine, engineering.
- 1990s: Expanded graduate programs disciplines.
- 2014: Best Global Universities.




Methodology for these Expanded Specialties Is Based on Peer Perceptions

- Two contacts at each universities rate universities in the discipline
- Limited to programs accredited by a specialized accreditor
- Calculate a composite score
- Score used to rank institutions.





Healthcare Quality and Safety Programs


- U.S. News has a minimum number of programs ...5 ... to be able to have a specialty filter on their website for health management. This is true of the other health programs that they rank.
- Currently, there are 4 accredited HQS programs, therefore...
- CAHME will NOT supply U.S. News with HQS sub-specialty programs as of this listing as we did not reach 5.
- When we reach 5 accredited HQS programs, they will be added to the database.
- Approved by the CAHME Board on August 10, 2024.




CAHME Data Used by U.S. News

- CAHME provides a list of universities with accredited programs, and two main contacts for each university with accredited programs.
- Universities with multiple CAHME accredited programs are listed once.
 - An exception is made if the programs are in different schools in the university, in which case each school will be listed once.
 - An example of this is Boston University which has an MBA program in the Questrom School of Business and an MPH in the School of Public Health.
- Each university gets 2 votes.


