


CAHME/Tim Campbell Scholarship for Selfless Service to Others and the Community

Note: The instructions below are divided into two sections. The first section provides guidance for the program director or faculty member completing the application. The second section outlines the steps for the nominated student to complete their portion of the application.

CAHME Application Instructions (Program Director/Faculty Member)

- 1. Click on the link <u>here</u> to access the CAHME/Tim Campbell Scholarship for Selfless Service to Others and the Community application.
- 2. Once you click on the link, you will be brought to the login page.



3. Create an Account by filling out the appropriate fields. Then, login using your information.

**Note: Once you log in, you'll be able to save your progress and return to it anytime.



4. Read through the first tab (Eligibility Information). Once you read it through, hit Save and Next.



Eligibility

- Student in CAHME Accredited or Certified Program
- Nominations must be made by the students Program Director, or a faculty member on behalf of the University Program Director
- Online applications must be submitted by October 17, 2025.


Award Includes

5. Read through the second tab (Applicant Information). Fill out "Application Name" and select from the dropdown menu for "CAHME Accredited or Certified Program Confirmation" section. Once complete, hit Save and Next.




- 6. Fill out the third tab (Program Nomination Essay). You will answer one essay question about the nominated student. Once you have completed the essay, hit Save and Next.
 - **Note: Feel free to write out your responses in a different document (ex. Word) and copy & paste them when complete.

- 7. Fill out the fourth tab (Nominated Student). In this section, you will enter the name and email of the student you nominated for this scholarship. Once you fill out this information, hit Save and Next.
 - **Note: The nominated student will be responsible for completing two essay questions associated with the scholarship. They will receive an email with a link to answer the two essay questions to complete the application.



8. You will be brought to the fifth tab (Selection Process). Once you have finalized all fields of the application, hit Save and Finalize.



9. When you hit Save and Finalize you will receive the message below:



Press OK to Submit your Application. You will not be allowed to make changes after submitting.

Press Cancel to return to the Application.

You may also press 'Save' instead of 'Save and Finalize' to save and return later.



10. Hit Ok which will bring you to the page below.


