

CAHME Application Instructions (Program Director/Faculty Member)

- Click on the link <u>here</u> to access the CAHME/Judy Baar Topinka Foundation Scholarship for Health Policy application.
- 2. Once you click on the link, you will be brought to the login page.



3. Create an Account by filling out the appropriate fields. Then, login using your information.



5. Read through the second tab (Applicant Information). Fill out "Application Name" and select from the dropdown menu for "CAHME Accredited or Certified Program Confirmation" section. Once complete, hit Save and Next.



6. Fill out the third tab (Program Nomination Essay). You will answer one essay question about the nominated student. Once you have completed the essay, hit Save and Next.




Nominees for this award exemplify the following qualities:

 Serve the public good through meaningful contributions in public health roles or distinguished volunteer service that positively impacted individuals or communities.
